Hosting International Students Rewarding for Bensalem Alum

If your children are living away from home and you miss the rhythm and excitement of having teens in your home, I have an excellent solution for you.

Why not consider hosting an international high school student for a whole school year. These students are good kids whose goals are to learn, even master, the English language and to become totally immersed into the American culture.

The amazing benefits of hosting an international student are many. For one, you get to see America through their eyes. Their questions and observations really make you stop and think about how great this country is, and somehow through the whole experience you find a renewed gratefulness and appreciation of being an American. Another joy you'll see is how they progress in their language skills. One day they're shy and reserved, embarrassed about their communication skills. Then it what seems like in no time at all they're spewing all kinds of colloquialisms and telling jokes. And finally, you'll find that most of these kids are very loving. Once they get to know you and the trust factor has been established, you become a permanent part of their hearts for the rest of their lives.

Here's how it works: an agent will send you

a list of teens, anywhere between the ages of 15 and 17, from other countries who greatly desire to attend an American high school for the entire school year. They will also ask you to fill out an application and will do a thorough screening on your background to ensure you'll be able to provide a safe and wholesome environment. The students are screened as well. Their past behaviors are heavily scrutinized. Their last 2 years of grades and attendance records must meet specific scholastic requirements. Additionally, the students must be at least 60% proficient in English language skills: conversation, reading, and writing.

All that is asked of you is to provide them with sleeping quarters, three meals a day and to love them, encourage them, and take an interest in their school life and activities.

Last year, Bob and I hosted two girls: Fanny from France and Giselle ("GiGi") from Bolivia. This year we are hosting two boys: John from France and Steven from Beijing China. I cannot begin to tell you how much joy these kids have given us, along with the welcomed activity and liveliness they bring into our home. After you've hosted an international teen, they will always be a part of your family, a part of your family's memories, and a part of your heart forever. And somewhere out there in this vast world you'll know that you've touched and made a difference in someone's life.

I hope I have stirred an interest within you and that you'll consider looking further into this rewarding experience for you and your family. Feel free to email me if you'd like to know more about our personal experiences.

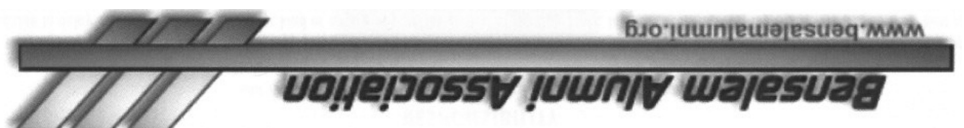
