Additionally, if you know someone in this section who does not have a rose next to their name, please add a comment to their page to share your memories.

All of our yearbooks since 1925 are now scanned and ready to be posted online! If you're a techie or just interested in this project, maybe you have some ideas of how we can do this most efficiently (and cheaply). Let us know if so.

Another function of our

association is to help people connect with others. If someone wants to find an alumni member but is having trouble, we will help by sending a letter to the missing party with the name and phone number of the person looking for them. Please note that we never give out address or phone numbers without alumni permission. 




