We all go through life and get to know so many people. Often, the people we grew up with are more important than all of the others we meet over the years. If you read the comments, I think you’ll agree that hearing about old friends can stir up some powerful and meaningful emotions. If you know someone who has passed away and is not in our “In Memory” section, I encourage you to let us know so we can honor their lives there. Additionally, if you know someone in this section who does not have a rose next to their name, please add a comment to their page to share your memories.

All of our yearbooks since 1925 are now scanned and ready to be posted online! If you’re a techie or just interested in this project, maybe you have some ideas of how we can do this most efficiently (and cheaply). Let us know if so.

Another function of our

association is to help people connect with others. If someone wants to find an alumni member but is having trouble, we will help by sending a letter to the missing party with the name and phone number of the person looking for them. Please note that we never give out address or phone numbers without alumni permission. This year we have a request from a Ron Christian and a Vietnam Veterans group looking for Ben Hughes who graduated in 1963. The want to find him to verify a battle where Lural Lee Blevins III was heroically killed in a battle while saving many men. They are not sure of the name or year. One of our members told us it may be Ben Herb ’63 because this person was

known to wrestle for BHS. If this sounds familiar, please help us track down this witness so he can help a hero be honored.

Looking ahead to our new year together, remember: the next golf outing is June 14, 2017 at Bensalem Township Country Club. Be sure to get us your name and number if you want more information. Our picnic will be in September, but right now we are not sure of the exact date. You’ll have a great time if you go, so get us your name soon so we can put you on our invite list!
