**Richard Dougherty**

**Alumni Scholarship Award**

This scholarship award is in honor of Richard Dougherty, affectionately known as "Doc."

Doc died on April 5, 1997 at the age of 60 years.

He was sports editor of the Bucks County Courier Times where he worked for 43 years.

Doc helped many students and friends, always in a quiet way, wanting no recognition for his efforts.

When Bensalem called on Doc, he was always there for us.

Doc liked to work with children and coached many teams in the CYO League.

After Doc's passing, our alumni received many letters from coaches and players from all sports throughout the country praising Doc for his fairness in reporting and his high moral standards.

Doc graduated from Bensalem in 1954. He loved his school.

**Bensalem Township High School**

**Samuel K. Faust**

**Alumni Scholarship Award**

Mr. Faust was a graduate of West Chester State Teachers College and the University of Pennsylvania.

In 1923 Mr. Faust came to Bensalem as superintendent, being charged by the school board to reorganize the elementary schools and to develop a high school.

At the time, Bensalem had no high school; therefore, Bensalem students of high school age were sent to other schools in nearby towns—Bristol, Langhorne, Jenkintown, and Frankford.

Mr. Faust died in 1940.

Mr. Faust won the respect of teachers and students alike for his thoroughness and fairness.

The Samuel K. Faust Elementary School was built in the Nottingham section of Bensalem in 1956 and named in his honor.

## **Bensalem Township High School Jack & Dolores Tilley Hansen Alumni Scholarship Award**

In 1983, Dolores and Jack Hansen became actively involved in reorganizing the Alumni Association.

They started a golf outing to raise funds for scholarships for Bensalem graduates.

Along with other members they set a goal of \$100,000.

This goal was reached because of the efforts and hard work of Dolores and Jack Hansen.

Both have been inducted into the Bensalem Sports Hall of Fame  
being outstanding athletes and later became very active with the organization.

Jack is a retired employee of the school district as Facilities Manager.

He also served on the school board for ten years and served as President.

Jack for many years has been the president of the Alumni Assoc.,  
putting endless hours of work to compile the Alumni Directory listing classes from 1925 to 1995,  
with his helper Dolores. Jack oversaw helping classes with reunions and helping find lost classmates,  
along with sending out newsletters to classmates.

Dolores was the vice president and the treasurer for many years.

The monies raised have been invested, enabling us to award scholarships for many years to come.

Because of Dolores and Jack's love and dedication to Bensalem,

The Alumni Association voted unanimously to give a scholarship to a deserving student each year  
in the name of Dolores and Jack Hansen, Jack, Class President, Class of '47 and Dolores, Class of 1951.

They are truly Mr. and Mrs. Owl.

We are proud to give this award out in their names so they both can see the good that it does.

## **Bensalem Township High School Thomas Jerome Mitchell Alumni Scholarship Award**

Tom Mitchell graduated from Bensalem High School in 1947.

He attended Texas A & M University and graduated from the United States Naval Academy  
at Annapolis, Maryland in 1953.

He served on a destroyer in Korean waters and then transferred to the Navy Civil Engineer Corps.

He attended Rensselaer Polytechnic Institute earning a degree in civil engineering  
and acquired a Master's Degree from Stanford University and the University of Rhode Island.

He attended the Naval War College in Newport, Rhode Island.

Tom reached the rank of Navy Captain in 1973.

He served in many capacities at naval facilities throughout the United States.

He was the First Officer in Charge of the Navy's nuclear power plant supplying power  
for the Scientific Station at McMurdo Base in Antarctica.

He served as Personal Aide to the Chief of Civil Engineers.

While serving as Commander of the Regiment of Seabees in the Pacific in 1974,  
Captain Mitchell was killed in a terrorist attack, along with two other officers,  
on the Subic Base in the Philippine Islands.

His life demonstrated his values of patriotism, love of family, belief in the power of education  
and gratitude for his roots in this community of Bensalem.

Tom's wife also graduated from Bensalem in 1947.

His wife, Lois, their son Tom and daughter Lee sponsor this scholarship in his memory.

**Bensalem Township High School  
Mrs. Florence Gerhart Muller  
Alumni Scholarship Award**

Mrs. Muller was a lifelong resident of Bensalem Township.  
She attended twelve years of schooling in Bensalem and graduated in 1929.  
She then attended and graduated from Temple University in 1933.  
Mrs. Muller taught and coached winning teams for Bensalem.  
She is the only person who has been inducted into the Bensalem Sports Hall of Fame twice—  
first, for her outstanding records in track including equaling the world record in the 50 yard dash,  
and second, for her dedication and commitment to excellence in coaching.  
Mrs. Muller died December 5, 1993.  
As an outstanding, dedicated alumnus of Bensalem,  
The Florence Gerhart Muller Alumni Scholarship Award was instituted in her honor in June 1993.

**Bensalem Township High School  
Miss Cecelia Snyder  
Alumni Scholarship Award**

Miss Snyder was a lifelong resident of Bensalem Township.  
She attended Cornwells Grammar School and Temple High School in Philadelphia.  
Bensalem had no high school.  
After graduating from the University of Pennsylvania, she started teaching in Bensalem in 1905.  
Miss Snyder became a teaching principal in 1923 and was named High School Principal in 1934.  
Miss Snyder spent 46 years of untiring devotion to her students before retiring in 1951.  
For outstanding achievement and faithful service to Bensalem,  
the Board of School Directors in 1960 named the new school on Hulmeville Road  
the Cecelia Snyder Middle School in her honor.  
Miss Snyder died in 1975.






